## HEROES OF HOLY CROSS: Blessed Basil Moreau CSC

**Part 3 of 3:** Later, amid crises and controversies in the Congregation, Moreau resigned as superior general. He lived his

last days estranged from his community but remained active preaching missions until his health failed. The Marianites cared for him until his final days, when Moreau died in Le Mans on Jan. 20, 1873. Fr. Basil Moreau, C.S.C., was beatified, by order of Pope Benedict XVI, on September 15, 2007, the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, in Le Mans, France. Blessed Basil Moreau remains an inspiration to men and women who live his vision of "bringing hope to others" in more than 15 countries throughout the world. Work continues today on his cause for canonization.
