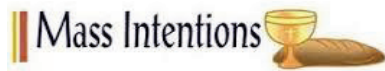

In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our Baptism, as it offers each one of us an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized. How can I help to make life sustainable, end extreme poverty, fight inequality, and lessen the effects of climate change? Here are some ideas that will have an impact on our Common Home:

- Do a bit of online research and buy only from companies that you know have sustainable practices and don't harm the environment.
- Use a power bar to plug in electronic devices and turn off when they are not in use.
- Taking a short shower uses less water than taking a bath.
- Avoid pre-heating the oven. Unless you need a precise baking temperature, start heating your food right when you turn on the oven.
- Plug air leaks in windows and doors to increase energy efficiency.
- Turn out the lights when leaving the room, Last Out Lights Out!
- Ride a bike, take public transit, carpool!
