# From The Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

Divine Mercy Sunday: This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. It celebrates God's special steadfast love for us. Through Saint Faustina Kowalska we have received a devotion to God's Divine Mercy expressed in the person of Jesus Christ our saviour. This devotion brings lots of graces and blessings to those who pray it. May we come to experience God's unfailing love each day. May His love inspire us to love Him back and to love one another. "The LORD is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love."

Capital Campaign: In view of building stronger and vibrant parishes, the whole diocese is embarking on a capital campaign to raise funds in support of our parishes and pastoral ministry in the diocese of Hamilton. We would be kindly asked to give a little extra than we used to if we can, or ask others who can help to support us. The target would be our general receipt for the year end (about 300,000). 75% of what we raise would stay in our parish to be used to revitalise our parish. Our parish would identify what our needs are and the funds would be put to that use. Moreover, the rest of the 25% would go into supporting

Hospital Ministry, Prison Ministry, Supporting Immigrants, supporting less endowed parishes etc. Our Parish (St. Eugene and St. Johns) are in the first wave after those parishes who participated in the pilot wave. There would be a lot of engagement on this campaign starting this June. We shall need people to be part of a **Capital Campaign Team**, to help us make decisions, plan and raise funds.
