From the Pastor's Desk:

Jesus in today's passage of the gospel invites us to be in an intimate relationship with Him: If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask for whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. My father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples. This relationship is fundamental for a true follower of Jesus because without the Lord we cannot do anything good. The more time we spend with Jesus the more we will learn to love the Father and our neighbours. The clue to achieving for what we ask is our faithfulness to the Lord despite the circumstances. This week we begin the month of May. The Holy Father asked the faithful throughout the world to pray for the following intention: That the lay faithful may fulfil their specific mission, by responding with creativity to the challenges that face the world today.

The month of May is also called a Marian month because of our special devotion at that time to Our Lady. Mary, the Blessed Virgin, perfectly fulfilled the will of the Father and she became a model for us in how we should respond to God's call.

This Sunday we complete our parochial pilgrimage to the Holy Land with a solemn morning mass in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. With glowing hearts and spiritual strength we are coming back home to share the Good News we have experienced.

This week we observe the following liturgical celebrations: St. Marie De L'Incarnation, Religious; St. Joseph the Worker; St. Pius V, Pope; St. Athanasius, Bishop and Doctor of the Church; St. Philip and St. James, Apostles; Blessed Marie-Leonie Paradis, Virgin; and the first Thursday, Friday, and Saturday of the month.

St. Athanasius, whose memorial is held on May 2nd, was a patriarch of Alexandria in Egypt in the 4th century. He is well known as a tireless defender of the Catholic faith against Arius and his followers who denied the divinity of the Son of God. Due to his steadfastness and uncompromising attitude towards the true Catholic faith he was banished from his Episcopal See five times and spent a total of 17 years in exile.






