# From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

The Liturgy of the Second Sunday of Advent presents to us two people of great importance: the Prophet Isaiah and St. John the Baptist. The first one is called an evangelist of The Old Testament because he wrote a lot about the coming Saviour. St. John the Baptist was only one of the prophets who pointed out the Saviour. His prophetic words about Jesus Christ: *Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world* are used during each Mass just before Holy Communion. He was sent to prepare the way to the Lord, so he appeared in the wilderness to proclaim a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins as the Prophet Isaiah had prophesized. Their prophecies are not out-of-date but today encourage us to come back to the Lord and make room for Him in our hearts.

I would like to invite and encourage everyone to approach the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the season of Advent, so that we all may prepare our hearts for the Saviour that was foretold by the Prophet Isaiah and St. John the Baptist. The schedule of Confession is inserted into this bulletin and may be found in the lobbies of the church too.

We continue the new initiative to have a Christmas raffle in our Parish to support our church and have some fun with the draw and prizes in our parish community. I would like to express thanks to those who got involved in providing the raffle and those who bought the tickets.

This week we celebrate: Saint Damasus I, Pope; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas; Saint Lucy, Virgin and Martyr; and Saint John of the Cross, Priest and Doctor of the Church.

On December 12<sup>th</sup> we observe a feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. There is a beautiful story about Juan Diego to whom the Blessed Virgin appeared in 1531 in Mexico. He was a simple farmer and labourer. While he was making his way to Mass in the early morning of December 9<sup>th</sup> Our Lady became visible to him as a native princess and her words sounded more beautiful than the sweetest music ever made. She wanted him to bring a message to the local bishop, so that a temple dedicated to her might be built. A miraculous sign was given to the bishop: on Juan Diego's tilma (outer garment) was made an exquisite image of Our Lady. This picture is still venerated in the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. For a special attention deserve the eyes of the Blessed Virgin in this picture because with a zoom lens we can see in them another image... Pope Pius XII in 1945 decreed Our Lady of Guadalupe to be the Patroness of the Americas.
