From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

This year the 4th Sunday of Advent opens the fourth week of Advent and simultaneously concludes this season because tonight we will also celebrate the first Mass of Christmas. Last week I tried to turn our attention towards the Advent Antiphons and today I am doing so too. The Entrance Antiphon of the 4th Sunday of Advent contains a humble request to heavens: "Drop down dew from above, you heavens, and let the clouds rain down the Just One; let the earth be opened and bring forth a Saviour". The Liturgy paraphrasing the words of the Prophet Isaiah compares the Saviour, who is to come, to dew and rain coming down. The earth is like a mother who is to give birth. We know that the earth without water becomes dry and unable to bear any fruit. It remains barren and infertile until rain and dew make it alive again. This metaphor well

In this affectional way today's Liturgy prepares us for the mystery of the Nativity of the Lord and, saying more precisely, it tells us how to make this mystery present in our hearts. Our hearts are like the barren and infertile soil until the dew and rain from above come down and water them with the Divine grace. We not only celebrate the day when Jesus Christ was born but as well we want Him to be born again in our hearts and make His dwelling place there.

On Christmas Day we tell each other our best wishes. This year I would like to wish all our parishioners and visitors to accept with joy this Divine Dew that is Jesus Christ, our Saviour, and to let Him dwell in our hearts, so that He may bestow upon us His precious gifts of love, hope and peace. Please, abundantly draw blessings from the Solemn Eucharist and His humble crib and bring them back to your homes, so your dwelling places may be filled

with the Divine Grace that is the best Christmas present.

I would like also to thank all those who have dedicated their time and skills to decorate our church for Christmas, who have donated to the flowers and who have sent to the parish and personally to me Christmas wishes. May the Newborn Child bless you all and keep you in His open arms.


