From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

The Feast of The Holy Family directs our eyes and thoughts the house in Nazareth where the Holy Family mostly lived. Looking at the home of Jesus, Mary and Joseph we ask our Heavenly Father to bless abundantly our families, so that they may follow the example of the Holy Family of Nazareth. On the occasion of today's feast it is interesting to mention the Basilica of the Holy House in Loreto, Italy. This is one of the most sacred and most important shrines of the Blessed Virgin. Yet, the history of Loreto presents to believers and honest disbelievers one of those eloquent questions of faith ever posed to rational scepticism... It is said that the House of Nazareth, the home of the Holy Family, had been brought by angels from Nazareth to the Dalmatian coast and later, by the same angels, transported to Loreto where it stands today enclosed in a huge Basilica. In the center of the House of Nazareth, there is a replica of a wooden statue of the Madonna. The original one, made of cedar of Lebanon, arrived at Loreto together with the house but has been destroyed. This history seems to be completely legendary but it is based partly on tradition and partly on historically recorded facts, which really make it interesting and noteworthy. Since 1294 numerous pilgrims from all over the world have visited the Basilica of the Holy House and among them there were almost 50 popes who made a pilgrimage during their pontificates. The litany to Our Lady, which in a very beautiful and poetic way sings of her virtues and meaning for heaven and earth, is called the Litany of Loreto.

On January 1st we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, which is the holy day of obligation. On this feast we honour Mary's motherhood of Jesus. In 451 Mary was officially called by the Council of Ephesus *Theotokos*, which literally means 'Bearer of God'. We profess that Mary truly bore the Son of God, Jesus Christ who has both divine and human natures. This feast concludes the Christmas Octave that is 8 days in which we celebrate the Nativity of the Lord, and it is the first day of the New Year. Remaining in the joy of the Nativity we ask the Lord to bless us at the beginning of 2018, so that may look forward to the entire year with the hope of His grace.

This week we observe a memorial of Saints Basil the Great and Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops and Doctors of the Church; and first Thursday, Friday and Saturday of the month. On January 2nd along with the memorial of St. Basil and St. Gregory we celebrate the day of episcopal ordination of Bishop Douglas Crosby, Bishop of Hamilton. Let us pray for the intentions of the shepherd of the Diocese of Hamilton and his ministry among the faithful.
