Dear Family of God:

DEVOTION BEFORE MASS: As part of our mission to grow into a community of prayer united in Christ, we shall have a 5-minute devotion before Mass each weekend. Prayer cards are available in the pews.

FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: will be celebrated on Wednesday 8th December, 2021 at 8:30am. *There will be rosary prayers before Mass.* This feast started around the 7th century and it celebrates the purity of Mary who was born without original sin. We are reminded of our call to holiness as children of God.

SYNOD OF BISHOPS: from 2021 to 2023 the Catholic Church across the world is embarking on a journey of *sharing, reflecting and listening*. The theme of this synod

is "**Towards a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission**." The Synodal process was opened this year 10th October 2021. In his homily, Pope Francis stated that "Celebrating a Synod means walking on the same road, walking together..." This synod will give opportunity for the bishops and the whole church to reflect on communion, participation in the life of the church and our call to be a missionary church.

Pope Francis is asking **each and every one of us** to become involved in the synodal process leading up to the Synod of Bishops to be held in Rome in 2023. The Pope tells us that the point of a synodal Church - "is to listen, as the entire People of God, to what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church."
