

COUNTDOWN TO LENT Lent begins on Wednesday, February 14th with Ash Wednesday. We will be having a School Mass at 10am and an evening Mass at 7:00pm, all are welcome at either Mass. Distribution of ashes will take place at each Mass. <u>Please note:</u> there is no morning Mass on Wednesday Feb 14th. Also, we will be having Stations of the Cross on Fridays in Lent beginning at 6:30pm, with Confessions to follow until 8:00pm. Please let family and friends know of these times so everyone has the opportunity to attend.

In Canada, **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence from meat. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years and older must abstain from meat.

Fasting means partaking of only one full meal and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Besides those outside the age limits, those of unsound mind, the sick, the frail, and pregnant women are excused from fasting/abstinence

The other Fridays in Lent are normally days of abstinence from meat, but Catholics in Canada may substitute special acts of charity or piety. The Obligation of one or the other remains. Travelers outside of Canada are not exempt from the universal law of abstinence from meat on Fridays during Lent.

Dear Parishioners,

We have had healing vigils here at St. Eugene church on the 3rd Friday evening of each month since this past September. During this Lenten season there will be changes to this format. There will be no Eucharistic Exposition, Benediction and Mass on Friday February 16th or on Friday, March 15th. Instead, the church will have Stations of the Cross on those dates. We warmly invite all who usually attend the vigils to join in this time-honoured devotion, the Stations of the Cross.

At the conclusion of the Stations of the Cross our prayer team will be available if you wish us to pray with you for your intentions and those of your loved ones. We will resume the healing vigils on the third Friday evening of April and in the following months.
