Countdown for Lent (February 22): Lent is soon approaching, let us prepare. Lent begins with the celebration of Ash Wednesday on February 22nd this year. "Lent is a time for penance and repentance, for almsgiving and prayer, for working to change attitudes that are not pleasing to God." Lent is a great opportunity to grow spiritually and to make our lives and our world better.

Cash donations are welcome to support shipping. Cost of shipping a barrel is \$160.00, boxes cost \$40.00.
