From the Pastor's Desk:

The 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time presents to us Jesus proclaiming the word of God in the synagogue in Capernaum. As St. Mark recounts, all the people present there were amazed at Jesus' teaching. This teaching was different from that of the scribes because He taught them with authority. Numerous people decided to follow Jesus only just on account of the authority He had. Today we also need this authority in order to know what to do to get in the kingdom of heaven. The problem is that our modern society respects neither Jesus' authority nor any other authority that clearly states what is really good.

This week we begin the month of February. Pope Francis asks the faithful throughout the world to pray for the following intention: Say 'No" to Corruption – That those who have material, political or spiritual power may resist any lure of corruption.

This week we commemorate Saint John Bosco, Priest; The Presentation of the Lord; Saint Blaise, Bishop and Martyr; Saint Ansgar, Bishop; First Thursday, First Friday and First Saturday of the month.

On January 31st we observe a memorial of St. John Bosco who was a priest, an outstanding mentor of the young and a founder of the Society of St. Francis de Sales (the Salesians). He lived in the 19th century and was immensely successful with unruly boys using a minimum of restrain and discipline, lots of love, keeping careful watch over their development and encouraging them personally and through faith. He was canonized in 1934. St. John Bosco is called *Father and Teacher of Youth*.

On February 2nd we celebrate the Feast of The Presentation of the Lord, which occurs 40 days after the birth of Jesus and is also known as Candlemas Day or The Purification of the Blessed Virgin. In 1997 Pope St. John Paul II established a World Day of Consecration Life and instituted that its celebration falls on February 2nd. According to the Pope, the purpose of the day is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels as well as to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervour which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord".

Let us pray so that we all may live a life pleasing to God and those in consecrated life may be always faithful to the commitment they made on the day of their consecration.
