World Day of Grandparents and Elderly Pope Francis announced the establishment of a World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly at his Sunday Angelus in January of this year. The chosen day for the yearly celebration is the fourth Sunday of July, since it coinsides with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

This year, the first World Day celebration will take place on Sunday, July 25th and the chosen theme is : I am with you always".

Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life, sees the yearly event as "a gift to the whole church" since it stresses the importance of the pastoral care of the elderly as "a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community."

Parenting Tip: "When you thought I Wasn't Looking" is a poem written by Mary Rita Schilke Korazan. The poem provides every parent with much food for thought - it reminds us that we are always teaching. Our children watch and hear everything; we model with more power than we speak. When we model consistent behaviours they become enmeshed in our children's actions. They are watching how we speak, love, forgive, care, act towards others and so much more. The importance of faith is also modeled in family. Do they see their parents praying, attending and engaging in Mass, thanking God for the gifts in their lives, making faith a priority?
