#### WEEK DAY MASSES RESTORED!

If all goes as planned and everyone stays safe and healthy, we are hoping to restore the weekday Masses here at St. Eugene. The schedule would be as follows: Tuesday - 7pm, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday mornings at 8:30am This will begin on the first week of September.

#### SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION

The Sacrament of Confession will be available again by appointment with Fr. Andrew. Safety precautions apply – confession will be by appointment only, meeting Fr. Andrew in the church using the Courtyard door, sanitizing your hands and wearing a mask. Confession will be face to face in the church. Please call the parish office with questions and to book your appointment.

Mass celebrating **The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** will be held on **Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup>**. The Rosary will be prayed beginning at 9am with Mass to follow. All are reminded to follow safety procedures.

We are now on Summer hours in the Parish office Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 9am - 4:30pm Fridays we are open from 9am until 12noon.



#### Directives for our safety.

-we are asking that you do a self-assessment at home, if you are not feeling well, please do not attend Mass.

-masks are mandatory during Mass. However, if you have a breathing problem then a mask is not required

-we know some people have a chronic cough and it is allergy season, please do not worry or discriminate to those around you. It is natural to cough and sneeze. -the Offertory is after Mass where boxes are provided for your donation on your way out of the church

- for receiving Communion during Mass, an usher will be present and will usher ONE ROW / PERSON AT A TIME . Please attend to the minister on the same side of the church that you are sitting on. Please do not cross over. Communion must be received in your hand, remove your mask, and consume before walking away. The first and last pews in the church are reserved for those who are unable to walk up to receive Communion. Please leave these pews for those who need them.

- if you have questions, please ask the ushers. We are not able to gather in the foyers or in the body of the church before or after Mass, so please leave the building as soon as Mass is over as it needs to be cleaned and sanitized after each use.

-we are always in need of volunteers, as it takes many people in order for all of us to share in the celebration of Mass. Please call the parish office if you are willing to help at one of our Masses.

Thank you to adhering to these safety directives, as we work together during this time of reopening, with hope of getting back to our new normal.
