**World Day of Grandparents and Elderly** Pope Francis announced the establishment of a World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly at his Sunday Angelus in January of this year. The chosen day for the yearly celebration is the fourth Sunday of July, since it coincides with the feast of Sts. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.

**This year, the first World Day celebration will take place on Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup> and the chosen theme is : I am with you always".**

Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, prefect of the Dicastery for Laity, the Family and Life, sees the yearly event as "a gift to the whole church" since it stresses the importance of the pastoral care of the elderly as "a priority that can no longer be postponed by any Christian community."
