From the Pastor's Desk:

Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast - the words of today's Entrance Antiphon remind us of the meaning of the 4th Sunday of Lent. This Sunday is called *Laetare* Sunday getting its name from the first word of the antiphon in Latin. The feast of the Resurrection of the Lord is at last in sight – only 21 days left. This is our joy and hope, so the Liturgy encourages us in keeping our Lenten observances having before our eyes this Easter horizon. This Sunday is also considered as a day of relaxation from Lenten rigours. Some external signs may accompany this spiritual meaning: we can decorate the altar with flowers and rose-coloured vestments can be used instead of purple ones, which belong to the Lenten season.

The Liturgy of the Word presents to us a well-known conversation from the Gospel of St. John. Nicodemus, a member of Sanhedrin, comes at night to talk with Jesus. He is willing to see a powerful in word and deed Prophet of Nazareth but out of fear

he chooses to meet with Jesus under cover of the night. This fear was overcome by the Resurrection of the Lord, which Nicodemus experienced later.

This Saturday we observe an optional memorial of Saint Patrick, Bishop. He was a fifth century missionary and bishop in Ireland. St. Patrick is also known as the Apostle of Ireland. Some legendary stories are connected with St. Patrick. One of them explains the absence of snakes in Ireland. The legend states that all snakes were banished by the Saint chasing them into the sea after they attached him during a 40-day fast he was undertaking on top of a hill.

Tomorrow a school March break begins. Have some rest and come back safe and sound!


