From the Pastor's Desk:

On the 3rd Sunday of Lent the First Scrutiny may take place, as we can read in our Sunday Missals. Three Scrutinies belong to the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) and are to occur on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sunday of Lent. They are for the catechumens who are to receive the Sacraments of Christian Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion) on Easter Vigil. The word 'scrutiny' comes from Latin and means 'careful examination' or 'inquiry'. The beginnings of the scrutinies date back to way early Christianity. The Church always wanted catechumens to be confirmed in the faith before receiving the Sacraments. By this reason, the faith is the principal topic of the Liturgy of the Word during those three Sundays of Lent. This is a good opportunity for our parish community to reflect on our faith as the catechumens are called to do. It can strengthen our faith and help us to learn how far we have already walked on the path traced by the Lord. Being aware of the value that the Sacraments have was and still is of great importance. The account excerpt from the 4th chapter of St. John's Gospel (Jesus and a Samaritan woman), which is prescribed to the First Scrutiny and may be used even where the Scrutiny does not take place, tell us that the faith is born from a personal encounter with the Lord. The Samaritan woman encountered that and we are encouraged to meet Jesus in His word and Sacraments.

This week we observe optional memorials of: St. Perpetua and St. Felicity, Martyrs; St. John of God, Religious; and St. Frances of Rome, Religious.

On March 8th we commemorate Saint John of God who was a Portuguese-born soldier turned health-care worker in Spain. He lived in the 15th and 16th centuries. His followers later formed the Brothers Hospitallers of St. John of God, a worldwide religious institute whose members are dedicated to the care of the poor, sick and suffering from mental disorders. John was canonized in 1690.


