## From the Pastor's Desk:

"Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation" — in that way Jesus set out His disciples to continue His mission. The Lord just before He was taken up to heaven once again reminded His disciples of what they are to do. Today we as Jesus' followers are called to share in the same mission. The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord not only encourages us to continue the proclamation of the Gospel but also points to the celestial horizon that is our eternal destination. The Ascension took place forty days after the Resurrection and in many local Churches it is celebrated exactly on Thursday after the 6th Sunday of Easter but in other countries, like in Canada, it is transferred to the next Sunday so that the faithful may without great effort participate in the Mass.

Today we observe Mother's Day. We implore the Lord through the intercession of Mary, the Holy Mother of God, to bless abundantly all mothers.

This Sunday Catholics are invited to reflect upon the media of social communication and how these influence our lives as we hold the World Communications Day.

Last Saturday the Grade 2 students form St. David's and St. Eugene's Schools received Holy Communion for the

very first time. We keep them and their families in our prayers.

Next Sunday in our church Father Grayson Hope, a newly ordained priest, will preside all the weekend Masses. On Saturday May 5<sup>th</sup> Bishop Douglas Crosby OMI, Bishop of Hamilton, ordained three deacons to the priesthood so they may serve the people of God in the Diocese of Hamilton. We welcome Father Hope in our parish community surrounding him with our prayers and asking him for his priestly blessing.

This week we commemorate on May 14<sup>th</sup> the Feast of Saint Matthias the Apostle and on May 18<sup>th</sup> an optional memorial of Saint John I, Pope. According to the Act of the Apostles St. Matthias was selected to replace Judas and was received to the body of the Apostles. He is said to have preached in Judea, Cappadocia and on the shore of the Caspian Sea. Matthias was martyred in the Kingdom of Colchis (today in Georgia).






