### From the Pastor's Desk:

"Oh, Most Holy Trinity, Undivided Unity, Holy God, Mighty God, God Immortal, be adored." - Thus how the beautiful hymn describes the mystery of this solemnity. Every day we profess our faith in the Holy Trinity by making the sign of the Cross. This is a fundamental truth of our faith that we acknowledge God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit of one Divine nature in three Persons.

This week we observe the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary; a memorial of Saint Justin, Martyr; an optional memorial of Saint Marcellinus and Saint Peter, Martyrs; and the first Friday and the first Saturday of the month that are dedicated to the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary respectively

On June 1<sup>st</sup> we honour St. Justin who was one of the first martyrs in the Church. He is also known

as author of some theological dissertations. In one of them he describes the celebration of the

Eucharist that first Christians had. In structure that Mass is the same as our present Eucharist: the Liturgy of the Word with a homily, Petitions, Thanksgiving Prayer, Communion, Blessing, and the sending forth of the people with the intention of proclaiming the Gospel and serving the poor.

Let us rejoice whenever we celebrate the Eucharist!
