

We have come to the end of the Church's year. Next weekend begins the Season of ADVENT. "Advent has a twofold nature: It prepares us for Christmas, when we recall Christ's first coming among us, and it is also a time when we look forward to his second coming at the end of the ages. Advent is a season of joyful expectation." (Ordo, 2022-20223). Some of the symbolisms we use in Advent include the colour Violet and the advent wreath with its candles. Advent is good time for us all to renew our spirits to participate actively in our faith and welcome more people to encounter Christ, grow in faith and share what we have received.

On Thursday December 8th we shall celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary at 8:30am. There will be rosary prayers at 8:15am before the Mass.
