#### From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

The month of November is dedicated to remembrance of those who have passed away. We already began this memorial celebration on November 2<sup>nd</sup> praying in a special way for all the deceased Bishops, Priests, and Deacons who have served in the Diocese of Hamilton. We will continue our individual and common prayers for our departed brothers and sisters in various ways. On Saturday, November 11th at 11 am there will be a memorial Mass ordered by the Knights of Columbus. In our church there will be available a Book of Life, in which we will be able to write the names of our loved ones. For all whose names will be written in the Book of Life there will be two Masses celebrated on Sundays November 12th and 19th at 9 am in our church. On November 11th we pray in a special way for those Canadians who gave their lives in war. After every Mass next weekend we will sing the national anthem O Canada.

This week we commemorate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica; Saint Leo the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church; and Saint Martin of Tour, Bishop.

On November 9th the Church celebrates the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the oldest and highest ranking of the four major basilicas in Rome. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome, the official ecclesiastical seat of the Holy Father, the Bishop of Rome, not St. Peter's Basilica, as some people mistakenly believe. The Basilica was originally dedicated to Christ, the Saviour and centuries later co-dedicated to Saint John the Baptist and Saint John the Evangelist. In ancient Rome this was the church where everyone was baptized. It is the oldest church in the West, built in the time of Constantine and consecrated by Pope Sylvester in 324. This feast became a universal celebration in honour of the Basilica, as a sign of love for and union with the See of Peter. Let us pray for Pope Francis, the successor of St. Peter, observing this special feast.
