From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Friends,

With this Sunday we begin the month of October that is a Marian month dedicated in a special way to Our Lady of the Rosary. Every day numerous people throughout the world pray the rosary. According to pious tradition, in 1214 the rosary was given to Saint Dominic, the founder of the Dominican Order, in apparition of the Blessed Virgin. One of the forces that spread widely this simple prayer was the influence of Pope Leo XIII who was called the Rosary Pope. He issued 12 encyclical and 5 apostolic letters on the rosary, instituted the custom of daily rosary prayer in the month of October and added the invocation *Queen of the Most Holy Rosary* to the Litany of Loreto. Pope St. John Paul II in 2002 recommended an additional set called the *Luminous Mysteries* to the 15 rosary mysteries.

In October we are encouraged to pray for this papal universal intention: *That all workers may receive respect and protection of their rights, and that the unemployed may receive the opportunity to contribute to the common good.*

This week we commemorate: The Holy Guardian Angels, Saint Francis of Assisi and Our Lady Of the Rosary.

On October 2nd we hold a memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels. A guardian angel is an angel who is assigned to a particular person, group, kingdom or country. The idea of guardian angels may be found in the New Testament (Matthew 18:10; Acts 12:12-15). According to St. Jerome, the concept of guardian angels is in the "mind of the Church". Pope Francis said that according to Church tradition we all have an angel with us who guards us and he instructed everyone: "Do not rebel, follow his advice!"

On October 7th we observe a memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. In 1571 Pope Pius V established the feast of Our Lady of Victory to commemorate the victory over the Ottoman navy at the Battle of Lepanto. 2 years later Pope Gregory XIII changed the title of the feast to the feast of the Holy Rosary and in 1960 Pope St. John XXIII changed the title to the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

Catholic Students, staff and parents walk in the 14th Annual Pilgrimage on Sunday, October 15th. Thousands of Catholic students from every school within the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board, along with teachers, support staff and parents, will embark on the Board's 14th annual Pilgrimage. The students will walk 8km in support of the poor of the Global South. "Walk with Christ: Justice for the Poor" is an annual board-wide fundraiser which, since 2004, has raised more than \$500,000 for development projects in the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Uganda, as well as the Holy Childhood Association and the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace. Walking in solidarity with the poor represents a pledge on the part of students to committing themselves to change the structures which generate the conditions, both locally and globally, which prevent people from living a full human life. The pilgrimage will begin with a Eucharistic celebration at Cathedral High School, at 11:00am sharp, followed by an 8km walk at approximately 12noon, up the Wentworth escarpment trail to St. Anthony Daniel Catholic Elementary school on Anson Avenue.
