World Mission Sunday: At the initiative of Pope Pius XI in 1926, the second last Sunday during October became known as World Mission Sunday. Catholics throughout the world are invited to pray for and give to missions. The collection this Sunday is organized by the Pontifical Missions Society. The funds collected assist some 1,250 mission dioceses under the responsibility of the Congregation for the Evangelisation of Peoples. As agreed by the Holy See and the bishops of Canada, a portion of the Canadian Contributions of this collection will continue to be used until 2020 to assist six diocese in Northern Canada which for many years had also been under the jurisdiction of the Congregation. I humbly encourage you to support this mission collection and mission work in the church. God bless you.

New Saints: Pope Francis has canonized England's Cardinal Henry Newman and four women at the St. Peter's Square, October 13, attended by 50,000 people from all continents. The four women are: Italy's Giuseppina Vannini (1859-1911), founder of the Daughters of Saint Camillus; India's Mariam Thresia Chiramel Mankidiyan (1876-1926), founder of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family; Brazil's Sister Dulce Lopes Pontes (1914-1992); and Switzerland's Margherita Bays (1815-1879), a laywoman. The first three spent their lives working for the poor.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults \sim What is it? It is the Church's process of welcoming newcomers into full communion with the Catholic Church. The program involves not just the newcomer, or 'inquirer', but all the members of the community, by prayer and personal example, help the inquirer find his or her place in the church. A lot of people benefit from RCIA~ for those who are already Catholic and are seeking a refresher, or want to learn more about their faith, for those who have never been baptized and see to join the community of believers (these men and women are called "catechumens"), for those already baptized in another Christian faith but seek to join the Catholic Church (these men and women are called "candidates"), and also for those people who are baptized Catholic but who have never been fully initiated through the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. These people are also "candidates".
