

**Mission Sunday:** This weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday. It is an opportunity to reflect on our life together as a missionary church and continue in the mission entrusted to us by Christ to evangelize the world and to make more disciples.

We are encouraged to pray for and give to missions. The collection this Weekend is used by the Pontifical Mission Society to support about 1,250 mission dioceses and six (6) dioceses in Northern Canada. Thanks to those who support through prayer, donations and dedication to a missionary spirit.

**First Friday Devotion:** As part of our vision to grow into a praying community united with Christ, beginning **November 5<sup>th</sup> 2020**, we shall start First Friday Devotions here at St. Eugene at **7:00pm.** We shall have a Mass followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with Chaplet of Divine Mercy and prayers to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion comes with many blessings and graces promised by Christ to St. Margaret Mary. All parishioners and neighboring parishes

are welcome to this devotion. NOTE: Our 8:30am regular morning mass will still take place as usual. However, on every First Friday we shall have two (2) Masses: 8:30am (regular Mass) and 7:00pm (First Friday Devotion Mass.)

Please obey social distance while waiting to light your candle, do not kneel on the kneelers in front of the candle, please stand at this time, and please do not spend too much time around the shrine so to make time for others.
