**RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults ~**

What is it? It is the Church’s process of welcoming newcomers into full communion with the Catholic Church. The program involves not just the newcomer, or ‘inquirer’, but all the members of the community, by prayer and personal example, help the inquirer find his or her place in the church. A lot of people benefit from RCIA~ for those who are already Catholic and are seeking a refresher, or want to learn more about their faith, for those who have never been baptized and see to join the community of believers (these men and women are called “catechumens”), for those already baptized in another Christian faith but seek to join the Catholic Church (these men and women are called “candidates”), and also for those people who are baptized Catholic but who have never been fully initiated through the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Confirmation. These people are also “candidates”.

**Our RCIA program begins on Tuesday, October 29<sup>th</sup> @ 7:30pm,** following the evening Mass, which begins at 7:00pm. The meeting will take place in the Bishop Tonnos Room. For more information or to register, please call the Parish office @ 905-549-2694.
