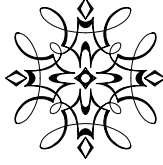

The Pastor's Corner
Peace and Goodness to All!

It is with great sadness that I inform you all, that **Fr. Raymond, (Mon) Luis SA** died on Tuesday morning at Rosary Hill Home in Hawthorn NY. Fr. Mon was long struggling with brain cancer and was operated on last October here in Toronto. He was then moved to St. Paul's Friary at Graymoor, I was able to drive him there. He enjoyed being with the friars there, then several weeks ago, for better care he was moved to the loving and tender hospice care of the Dominican Sisters at Rosary Hill. His mother was with him in the early morning hours when he passed. His mother, sister, brother and other family members mostly from the Philippines, were also very close by in Hawthorn. I had last seen Fr. Mon about a month ago, at the Rosary Hill home and he sent his love to all in the parish. We were notified of his condition almost daily and he has been in our prayers. On Tuesday the Mass for the "Merrymakers" senior gathering was offered for Fr. Mon before the monthly luncheon. Fr. Mon served as the Chaplain for the group in his last months here at St. Joan of Arc.

This morning some members of the parish community phoned to ask about the Funeral arrangements which will be held at Graymoor. The wake service at which I will preside will be held on Thursday evening April 26th at 7:00 PM, in the St. Paul's Friary Chapel. Fr. David Poirier, SA, his pastor from St. Paul's the Friar's parish in Richmond, BC, where he spent most of his 9 years as a priest, will deliver the eulogy. The Funeral Mass will be celebrated on Friday morning at the Graymoor Chapel with Fr. James Gardiner, SA presiding and preaching as Fr. Mon had requested. Fr. Mon's room at Rosary Hill contained a large bulletin board where he had posted dozens of cards. Many of these were hand made from the Children at the St. Paul's parish, in Richmond, many were from our own St. Joan of Arc parishioners. He was forever expressing his gratitude for the outpouring of prayers and best wishes that were offered and sent to him. I personally want to thank all of you for your prayerful support in this time. I am confident that he is now at peace with the Lord and is praying for all of us with the great crowd of witnesses in the heavenly vestal gathering at the throne of God. May he Rest in Peace.
