This is a difficult Friars Nook for me to write as it's my last. It took me more than 60 years to finally become a pastor, and I got to enjoy that privilege here at Joan of Arc. But together we managed to pull through the pandemic, and I believe we have come out of the other side of it stronger and continuing to grow as a parish.

I have chosen to love the people who have been entrusted to me for pastoral care. And so, leaving them causes some pain. Like a father with his children, I worry about your future, and I hope that it's filled with joy, growth, and blessings!

As I learned from my mother, I would rather lead with my heart and risk the pain than be closed off and feel nothing. It will still anger me if you are not treated well. But I hope that I have left you strong enough to stand up for yourself and your parish.

As I return to my hometown, my family is very excited that I'll be around them and I'm trying to make myself more excited to leave here and to be there. But for a while it will be just going through the motions. I love doing ministry and pray that God's fire of love may continue to burn bright in me in whatever I'm called to do. As I leave my heart with you may it be a source of comfort and strength to you always!
