The Pastor's Pen

Today's Bulletin is for June 29th and July 6th Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul - June 29th

St. Peter and St. Paul, were two most dynamic saints of the early Church. Both traveled to spread Christianity to Rome where they were martyred. They are the principal patrons of the Church of Rome. Peter was a fisherman, with no formal education. He responded to Jesus' call to follow and then stumbled his way through the Lord's public life, and beyond. He denied Jesus three times as Jesus faced his trial. In the end, Peter recognized that Jesus was the Messiah and professed, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Peter is the one upon whose faith Jesus built his Church. Peter became the first bishop of Rome. Paul was an educated man. He was small in stature. His name was changed from Saul to Paul as a bit of a joke, because Paul means small in Latin. He may have been small, but he was a dynamo. He did everything possible to destroy the followers of Jesus. He was present when Stephen was stoned to death. Paul went on raids, arresting Christians, turning them into the authorities. But the Risen Christ called Paul as he traveled to Damascus. Paul had a major conversion, and became the Apostle to the Gentiles! He helped spread the Good News to the ends of the earth! Both men laid down their lives for the faith!


The question put forth to Peter, "But who do you say that I am?" was answered in a very profound way by both Peter and Paul. What is our answer? I think we best answer that question by how we live our Christian lives. I'm sure there's some Peter and Paul in all of us. We all harbour some of their inadequacies and we also enjoy some of their strength. A great week to reflect on a few spiritual questions: Who is Jesus for me? And who am I for him? What am I willing to do for the sake of the Gospel, for the sake of the Kingdom of God? May we deepen our desire to serve the Lord in whatever way he calls us.

July 6th - 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time



In our Gospel this Sunday, Jesus sends out 72 disciples in pairs to do his work, to announce the Kingdom. They returned **filled with joy** at the things they did in his name. How can we not plug into that joy and excitement? Here's a good exercise for us this week: take a pen and

paper and write all the things we did in God's name this past week... that would have given God JOY? Would there be anything? Hopefully so! Then write a list of things we will do for God this coming week! Because 2000 years later, we're still being sent to announce the Kingdom. Our lives and actions must breathe the Kingdom! Just as the disciples brought joy and peace to the places they went, we must also be people of peace and joy! This can defeat evil, turn mourning into dancing! There's lots out there that need defeating! Even things in our own lives! Being a child of God, created in his image, being Baptized, means we are to love in a special way and be joyful. The Resurrection happened! Our role is to live it!!! Let's spread joy this week!
