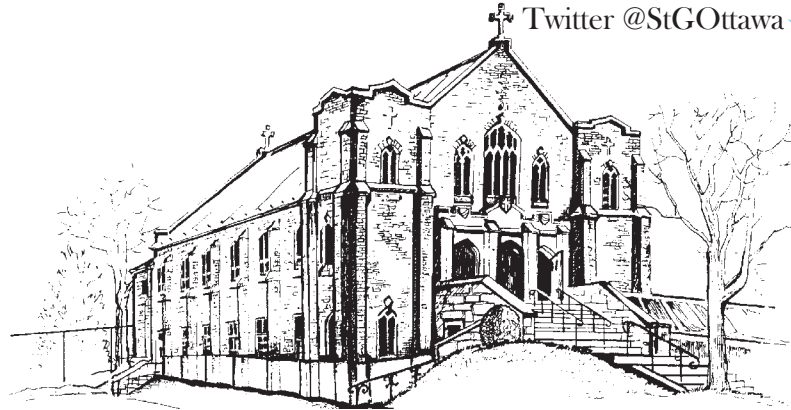

CORPUS CHRISTI MASS AND PROCESSION

Jesus is with us. He himself promised, "I will be with you to the end of time". This is true in many ways, there are many ways in which Christ is present, most of all he is present in Holy Mass, the sacrament of the eucharist. The feast of *Corpus Christi* allows us to celebrate this gift with appropriate solemnity, and give public witness of our faith in the real presence of Christ in his Church, in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

Over the past years, we have been celebrating this feast at St. George Church with ever greater participation, together with friends and parishioners not only from St. George's but also from the *Church of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary* and *St. Albertus German Parish*.

This year, you are invited to join the Corpus Christi Mass and procession on Sunday, **June 3** at 10:30 a.m., (**there is no 9 a.m. Mass**). Our principal celebrant will be *Most. Rev. Christian Riesbeck CC, Auxiliary Bishop and Vicar General* of our Archdiocese.

For this occasion, our various parish choirs, as well as readers and altar servers from the three churches will work together, singing, carrying flags, candles, incense and bells during the Mass and procession.

As in previous years, the procession will make its way to four altars, the first one at the Duss Brothers Car Shop (Wellington/Mayfair), the second one at The Church of the Annunciation (Carleton/Spencer), the third at the Gagliano house (Piccadilly), the last one on the front steps of St. George's Church. In case of bad weather, we will have a short indoor procession.

After the procession, everyone should come (and bring food, see below) to a potluck lunch in our Parish Hall.

DIOCESAN FEAST DAY CELEBRATION

This year, the celebration will be on June 14 at 7:30 p.m. at Notre Dame Cathedral. The archdiocese will acknowledge Mother Élisabeth Bruyère who recently had been declared Venerable by Pope Francis. The celebration begins with a visit and a moment of prayer at the Mother House of the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa.

The papal *Benemerenti* Medal will also be awarded to Georges Bouliane. Parishioners are invited to witness Georges receiving the papal decoration.
