



Explorers and Conservationists



During the summer, there are people who like to travel and there are people who like to stay at home and work in their garden. In the winter, there are those who like to venture into the outdoors to ski or skate or play in the snow and there are those who prefer to curl up in a

warm cozy place and read a book.


The Church has always maintained a <u>tension</u> between those who believe God is calling us to proclaim the Gospel in new ways and those who believe God is calling us to not lose sight of our roots. At times these two forces <u>seem to</u> be at odds with each other.

It's a bit of a paradox but <u>both</u> explorers and conservationists have a <u>key role to play</u>. The secret is that they have to always be <u>in communication</u> with each other.

For example, scripture scholars have explored a lot of new territory in the past 200 years. At one time, the story of Noah's Ark, in the Book of Genesis, was thought to be a true story in the way we think of history (date and time). Today, we say the story of Noah's Ark is true, not as historical fact, but because



it expresses an enduring truth about our relationship with God.



Conservationists have helped us to focus on the core teachings of our faith in a constantly changing social environment. For instance, although the Church sanctioned the practice of slavery, it came to

condemn the practice when it acknowledged that all human beings are made in the image and likeness of God. If you notice that at times bishops are at odds with each other or that parishioners seem to disagree with each other, remember - the Church needs both explorers and conservationists: those who can lead us to proclaim the Gospel in the future and those who can remind where we have come from.

We are not to worry. As St. Paul says, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."
