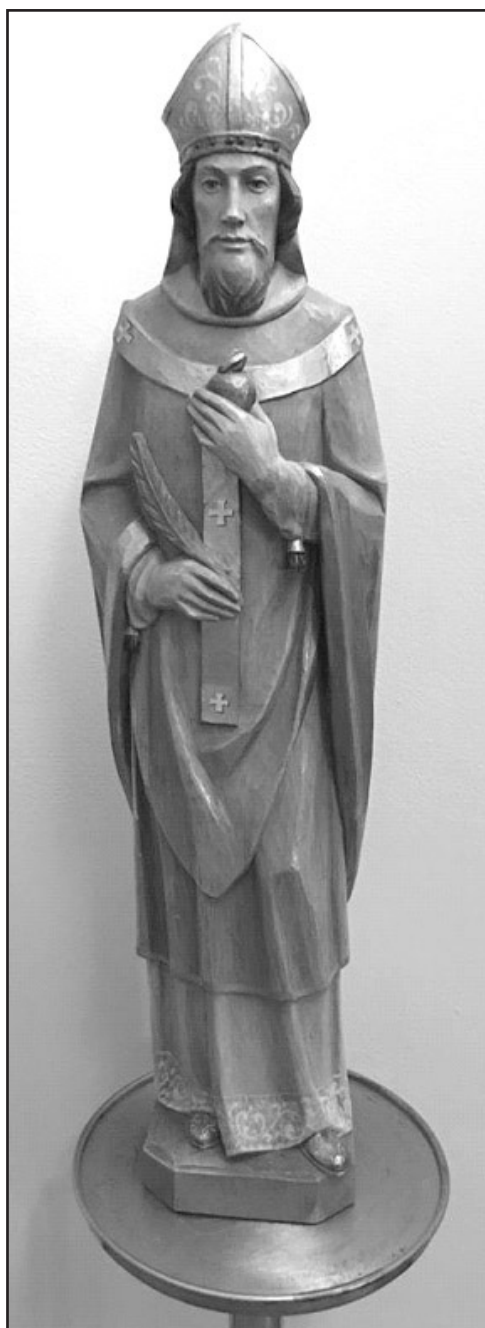

PASTOR'S DESKFOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER**Joyful Stewardship***"The disciples were filled with joy and the Holy Spirit." (ACTS 13:52)*
