Corpus Christi
Weekly Reflection

In 1264 the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*, Latin for "Body of Christ", was instituted by Pope Urban IV, who as an archdeacon was inspired by the visions of St. Juliana of Liège during Eucharistic adoration. In 1316, Pope John XXII introduced the traditional procession of Corpus Christi. This Solemnity also known as the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ honors Christ, who is really, truly, and substantially present under the appearances of bread and wine. Christ is also present within His Church, whose members are baptized into the Body of Christ. Pope Urban IV requested St. Thomas Aquinas to write special prayers and hymns for this Eucharistic feast, of which some well-known Eucharistic songs are *Tantum Ergo*, *Pange Lingua*, and *O Salutaris Hostia*.

Nel 1264 la solennità del Corpus Domini, in latino "Corpo di Cristo", fu istituita da Papa Urbano IV, che, da arcidiacono, si ispirò alle visioni di Santa Giuliana di Liegi durante l'adorazione eucaristica. Nel 1316, Papa Giovanni XXII introdusse la tradizionale processione del Corpus Domini. Questa solennità, nota anche come Santissimo Corpo e Sangue di Cristo, onora Cristo, che è realmente, veramente e sostanzialmente presente sotto le apparenze del pane e del vino. Cristo è presente anche nella Sua Chiesa, i cui membri sono battezzati nel Corpo di Cristo. Papa Urbano IV chiese a San Tommaso d'Aquino di scrivere preghiere e inni speciali per questa festa eucaristica, tra cui alcuni canti eucaristici molto noti sono *Tantum Ergo*, *Pange Lingua* e *O Salutaris Hostia*.

En 1264, la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi, que en latín significa "Cuerpo de Cristo", fue instituida por el Papa Urbano IV, quien, como archidiácono, se inspiró en las visiones de Santa Juliana de Lieja durante la adoración eucarística. En 1316, el Papa Juan XXII introdujo la tradicional procesión del Corpus Christi. Esta solemnidad, también conocida como el Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, honra a Cristo, quien está real, verdadera y sustancialmente presente bajo las apariencias del pan y el vino. Cristo también está presente en su Iglesia, cuyos miembros son bautizados en el Cuerpo de Cristo. El Papa Urbano IV encargó a Santo Tomás de Aquino que escribiera oraciones e himnos especiales para esta fiesta eucarística, de los cuales algunos cantos eucarísticos conocidos son *Tantum Ergo*, *Pange Lingua* y *O Salutaris Hostia*.

ANNUAL KNIGHTS of COLUMBUS BBQ

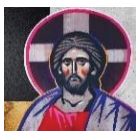
