## Ruminations...

Now that we have ushered in summer, it officially arrived June 21 at 12:24 am, that can mean only one thing – graduation season. Now the number of years, nay, decades since my grade eight graduation just scares me and boggles my mind because of how long it has been chronologically, yet seems just like yesterday, well maybe not yesterday but only a couple of weeks ago. By today's execution for grade 8 grads, mine was grossly underdone. We had a mass at Holy Martyrs of Japan with the certificates of completion handed out after the celebration. Then it was back to the school gym for a dance. There were no great decorations or balloons or displays, just some beverages and treats and home by ten. I remember my parents a little upset with me about the dress code. I had convinced them that suits and ties were not the order of the day so off to Woolworths to pick up a dressier shirt than the Adidas tee shirts that made up my wardrobe. Of course Upper Canada Mall hadn't quite opened at the time. I rather liked the new shirt, it was a pale orange. I have always liked orange even though it makes me look like a pumpkin. Well, I can still picture the look of horror and anger when we arrived at the church and all the other young gentlemen were in suit and tie. My parents were none too happy. Luckily the graduating class, all 24 of us sat apart from our parents. I am sure that I was the most comfortable person in the hot, stuffy church. At the dance, in the darkened gym, mostly the boys stood against one wall and the girls giggled on the other. There were no scenes of wailing of departure because for the most part, the groups would be attending the same high school, so it was just a short goodbye for the summer, something that had taken place since kindergarten since most of us had been together that long. Arriving home my younger brothers had decorated the kitchen to celebrate and there was a big gift wrapped sitting on the table. It was a stereo record player with speakers that were detached with lots of speaker cord to be placed around the room. At long last we could return the one we used which belonged to my cousin. Suddenly that K-Tel 22 Explosive hits sounded so much better on my own stereo. Looking back, it seems like such a small inconsequential event, even academically. At the time though, it represented a transition. All summer my gut was on edge with High School looming. Anytime anyone mentioned the words High School, I would break out in this ridiculous grin of fear and dread. It became a family sport, just passing by someone mention the words to watch moods change instantly into that embarrassing expression. That was my last formal graduation. High School was in the Fall after grade 13 and it seemed too much of a chore to make it down from Sudbury. University grad, well, Sudbury was too far to travel especially with my dad recovering from open heart surgery. My Masters grad, I

happened to be on crutches and so couldn't drive, and my Masters from the University of Notre Dame, the eight hour drive was too daunting with an ailing father. Those were decisions based on choices and there were other good things happening at the same time. Like all choices, something is lost and something is gained.
