

Next Sunday is ShareLife Sunday! (A second collection will be taken!) Working Wonders for people who are homeless...While at Matt Talbot, we helped Richard reunite with his brother, lost to him through separate adoptions, and deal with his mother's death, a woman he had mixed feelings about for she was the person who originally committed him to the system as a young child. Today Richard is working odd jobs. Drinks rarely and still has his apartment. Still overflowing with teenage-boy energy, although, he is approaching 60 and stands 6'6", there's a claim to Richard that's new. Some of that calm comes from the processing he did while in the Matt Talbot programme and some comes from us learning when to let go and move people along to the next phase of growth. In Toronto alone, there are a least 1,500 homeless people on any given night. On an annual basis, Sharelife agencies provide food, shelter, guidance, care and counselling to more than 10,000 people in the Greater Toronto area.
