ST. JOAN OF ARC PARISH SURVEY RESULTS

Recently, the Parish conducted a survey, encouraging comments from the community around the spiritual, social and service experience within our Parish.

We received 500 survey responses and the following is a short recap of the key feedback which was received from you. Thank you for your time and interest in our efforts. We ask you to reflect on this. We will host Town Hall meetings after the 10:00 am and Noon masses on the weekend of May 6 for all who wish to receive further information and contribute ideas for action.

We received responses from both married (49%) and single (34%) members of the Parish and most of the respondents were over 31 years old (91 %), with 50 % over 50 years old; 93% of the respondents rated the spiritual life of the parish as good or very good 93% of the respondents rated our hospitality as good or very good 91 % of the respondents rated Religious Education as good or very good 87% of the respondents rated our community outreach as good or very good 85% of the respondents rated the social vitality of the parish as good or very good

The specific comments within the feedback indicate that there is a strong appreciation for the Pastoral Leadership, that we are a friendly, welcoming parish and that the music ministry is strong.

96% of the respondents would recommend our parish to others.

In response to our questions about future programs and opportunities for improvement, we heard that Bible study, prayer groups, more youth involvement, and focused activities for young adults will further strengthen our parish.

Once again, we thank you for taking the time to provide your feedback and we invite you to attend one of the Town Hall meetings to be held after the 10 am and noon masses on the May 6th weekend.

We look forward to continuing the conversation with all of you as, together, we share in the stewardship of our Parish, now and into the future.


