

#### Christ is Risen as He Said, Alleluia!

Welcome to St. Joan of Arc Parish as we celebrate Easter joy. The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is now the source of our hope. These stories inspire us to consider the many ways that God continues to bring us new life in forgiveness, healing, hope and peace.




