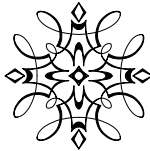

St. Joan of Arc's Catholic Women's League has been established for 59 Years as of January 8, 2023!

Fr. Bob is in Assisi and Rome this week. Because I have been a member of the League for just over 40 years. I am giving you some of the history of our League. Our Council has sponsored many activities over the years.

How did I become a member of St Joan of Arc's Catholic Women's League?

I remember the Over 50 Club, women would come in every Tuesday and play cards and do crafts. How I became involved in the CWL, was because of the Mother's Group. It met every Wednesday morning, the children in the hall with babysitters and the mothers in the meeting room having coffee and tea and this was sponsored by the CWL. After a couple of years in the Mother's Group, I decided I should join the CWL, to show my appreciation for what I got out of the Mother's group. I felt like I was part of the parish and had made friends in the parish.

Being a member of the CWL meant I could be involved as much or as little as I liked. We hosted Citizenship Courts, the first one was here at the parish hall on a very hot day. The Mountie that was present actually fainted as he stood on guard for the swearing in. After that all citizenship courts were held at the actual court.

We raised money through our rummage sales and Bazaars. We haven't had a rummage sale for years now, but up until Covid we were still having Bazaars.

The league has purchased lots of different things for the parish, tables and chairs. The Stained Glass window that is behind the choir that lights up and a lot more.

We were asked to do something for the 75th Anniversary, so we had a fashion show, from the 1920's to the 1990's. For this event we borrowed costumes from a theatre group to cover the span of 70 years. In 2007 we gave the parish \$10,000.00 towards the cost of the new kitchen.

When a member passes away, we put our CWL Banner by the altar and our members form an honour guard for the funeral mass.

We participate in different levels of the League, we have had two Regional Chairs, long ago, we had one of our members on the Archdiocesan executive. Some of our members have had convenorships on the regional and Archdiocesan levels of the league,

If you are interested in joining the League, our meetings are the 4th Monday of each month. Any woman 16 yrs. or older can join. Membership fees went up this year to \$32.00 for the year. If you are interested in learning more about the League, why not attend a meeting and see if it is for you. All women are welcome!
