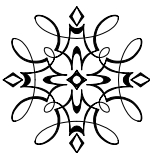

Happy Holy Week! This week we celebrate the most solemn feasts on the Christian calendar. On Thursday we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper which commemorates the Last Supper and Jesus's washing of his disciples' feet as an example to them to be of humble service to all of God's people. Friday, we celebrate Good Friday when Jesus was condemned and put to death for our sakes. Saturday evening we'll celebrate the Great Vigil of Easter as we ready ourselves for the wonder and mystery of the resurrection. And Sunday we celebrate the great feast of Easter! The Lord has triumphed and won over sin and death in our lives. Many of us feel that we need to triumph over sin and death but find that we can't. That's because it's beyond our doing we need the help of God. We might be able to "white knuckle" it for awhile but sooner or later we're bound to fail without God's help and grace. And that help and grace comes bountifully to us.

Last weekend I was away for a family funeral. A young man who was found dead in his bed at 33 years old. The police found no signs of foul play and his blood work came back clean, so there's no clear reason for him to die that young. I was there to comfort the family especially his parents who had lost their youngest child and reminded them that Jesus died at 33 as well. When I preached at the funeral, I reminded everyone that we don't know when our time is up. Certainly at 33 years of age we thought we had plenty of time in our lives to do the things we wanted to do or at least the things we should be doing but I reminded them that we need to be about the good we can do today because tomorrow is not promised.

This week will be busy for me I look forward to seeing many of you at our Holy Week services. But I also found out that I need to leave for Rome on Easter Sunday night. I'll be back in time for the next weekend, but I have to, do some legal and financial things for the friars in Italy. I must admit I'm not looking forward to the travel and missing time with my dog, Bodhi, but such is life. The fewer friars there are, the more we need to do. I can't hope for somebody else to do the work for me or to wait thinking, "I have plenty of time." God gives us the gift of life and Jesus gives us the gift of new life. He calls us to live that new life day by day that we may live our lives for him and his Kingdom.
