

I am so grateful to the parents and teachers of these children who have helped them come to the blessed awareness of Christ present to them and to all the Church in this most Holy Sacrament that is the source and summit of our faith.

We received good news this week that Jeff Lima, who has been involved in the stewardship and the RCIA ministry of our parish for the past three years, has been accepted in the formation program of the Carmelite Friars in Chicago Ill. During this world day of prayer for vocations, we are deeply grateful to God for his call and we will continue to pray for Jeff as he begins his journey in August of this year, and for all who are called to Religious Life and Priesthood.


