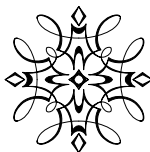

Thank you all for your support and prayers for me as I ran the Lake Placid Ironman Race this year for the 12th consecutive year. As you probably know, I finished this race consisting in a 3.8K Swim followed by a 180k bicycle ride through the mountains, followed by a 44.2K run, in 15 hrs. 55 Min, just a few minutes slower than last year.
