#### FROM THE DESK OF ROSANNE KELLY

Dear Loved Ones,

As you know, we are getting closer to my birthday. Every year there is an observance in my honour and I hope that this year we will celebrate again. During this time there are many advertisements in the media and many people shop for gifts. Everybody talks about the day of my birthday getting closer and closer.

It's very nice to know that, once a year, some people think of me. As you know, the celebration of my birthday began many years ago. At first, people really seemed to understand and to be appreciative of all that I'd done for them; but in these times, very few people seem to know the reason for the celebration. Families and friends get together but they don't seem to know much about why they are doing it.

I remember last year I decided to attend a great feast planned in my honour. The table would be loaded with delicious food, pastries, nuts and chocolates. The decorations would be exquisite and there would be many beautifully wrapped gifts. But - I wasn't invited! I was the guest of honour, and they didn't remember to invite me.
