The Finance Committee met this past week and it was an eye opening experience. First of all we need three more members on the committee. If you have any experience in this field and are interested in helping out please submit a resume to the office. They only meet six times a year so it's not a major time commitment.

We have been running at a deficit for the last few years. Our collections are down, and they are not covering the cost of running the parish. There are several reasons why this is occurring. Apparently when the Family of Faith program was introduced five years ago in the diocese, our collection took a hit as people were contributing more to the diocese and less to the parish. Hopefully, now that it is drawn to a conclusion our collection will come back up again.

We are also looking through a variety of ways seeking to gain new parishioners. Apparently in the past we have had to be concerned with overflow seating at Masses. Currently I have not witnessed this even in our Holy Day masses! We have plenty of room for new members and we're doing our part to make the parish a place of welcome, but we need you to do the inviting. Talk about Saint Joan of Arc parish to your friends, tell them why you like it here and why you choose to attend. We also hold many things apart from Masses that they could attend like social and prayer opportunities. Remember, all are welcome!

Another way you can help, is through bequests and wills. A number of years ago someone left the parish their house, which once sold was a great boon to the bottom line. We're trying to draw in younger members so that we can hand the faith on to future generations, but as you know the cost of living in Toronto is so high that many young families can't afford to live here.

Pre-Authorized Giving, PAG, is another way you can help. It allows us to pay our bills even when you are not here. If you already are signed up think about increasing what you offer. As you know the bills continue to rise even as we try to cut expenses so what you were giving doesn't go as far today.

I hate talking about finances, but if we continue at the rate we are, we'll be out of money in three years! Please give your stewardship some thought. Whether it's in increasing giving or increasing parishioners, we need your help. Let's make the parish shine in our corner of Toronto! **Peace, love and joy,**
