



THE PASTOR'S CORNER

As we begin our Lenten Journey we are particularly mindful of those who are engaged in the Rite of Christian Initiation and preparing to receive the sacraments at Easter. The RCIA, and RCIC, involve the rites of Christian Initiation for Adults and Children which are administered throughout the Lenten period. This year we have one child and one adult to be baptized at Easter. Hence we will celebrate the rites of Scrutiny during three different Sunday Celebrations of lent. We have staggered these to permit members of our congregation who attend different liturgies to participate in the rites. Of course we all participate as a parish with our prayers for those to receive the Easter Sacraments, and we thought it would be helpful for the participants of the RCIA to experience our different liturgy celebration communities. It is always fascinating to see how subtly different are the cultures of each of our Sunday celebrations. This Sunday the Book of the Elect will be brought forward for signing at the 10:00 Mass, to begin the Lenten process. Please keep in your prayers, the individuals who will be baptized and who will enter full communion with the Catholic Church at Easter time.

This past Monday the RCIA group sponsored the Winter Welcome Table dinner at St. Peters. It was a privilege to be there with them on Family Day as we chopped vegetables, and grilled chicken for the hearty soup appetizer before dinner. Frank Ficker, came in after our initial preparations to pull it all together for the guests. The Winter Welcome table is sponsored by The Atonement Friars, The Sisters of Sion and the Paulist Fathers. St. Joan of Arc and St. Peter's parishes gather groups to accomplish the meal preparations on alternating weeks, and the costs are split among the parishes and the religious communities. It is truly a communal effort in which we are all given a share to assist those in need of fellowship and a good meal.

The Building Committee met this week to review the progress of the Capital Campaign project. It was satisfying to see that there is much progress being made, with the hall and new Kitchen well underway, it looks like this portion may be completed by the end of February. The lighting in the Church will be delayed because we need to overhaul the electrical system throughout the building to bring it up to code, so we pray that we can find an engineering firm that can do the kind of work that will be required. The restoration of the outside will commence very soon. If the weather holds out, perhaps by Easter that will be completed, but with construction, we all know that time is not measured in predictable patterns. At any rate, it looks as though the projects continue to be held to budget, and so by God's grace, we move ahead. May good St. Joseph continue to be our patron on these projects.

As we continue our Lenten journey together this week, let us ask God to help us grow in Faith Hope and Love throughout this holy season, so we may truly celebrate the Pascal Mystery of Christ at Easter.
