

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

Today is the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. The stained glass window in the Choir area depicts this scene and is a familiar sight to all of us. The reason it is there is because originally there was a baptistery well in that corner of the church. This was changed some years ago to accommodate baptism celebrations in our Sunday Liturgies, and to position our choirs to facilitate congregational participation. This feast is always special to me because it was on this day that I first celebrated my Vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience in religious life. This year marks my 30th anniversary in vows, as a Franciscan Friar of the Atonement. This feast celebrates the beginning of the public life and ministry of Jesus. It is last day of the Christmas Season and transitions the Church into Ordinary time. We as a parish are also back on our regular schedules of Religious education, RCIA, and other ministry activities.

On Tuesday evening the Confirmation class of 2013 gathered with their parents and teachers to pray together, and become oriented to the program that will prepare them for the celebration of this sacrament in the spring. Thank you to Stephanie Ficker, Louis Martins, Cathi Richardson, and Marilyn Cicuttini who will be the teachers for the 22 confirmandi students. Special thanks to Cathi Richardson who stepped in to organize these efforts. As we welcome this class we ask your prayers for their growth and participation in the life of the Church.

The ministries committee met on Tuesday also to continue its work in augmenting the suggestions received from our recent parish survey. On Saturday the first "Blue Sky" gathering to discern directions for youth ministry was held and it gave us a great start in this venture. We are grateful to all who participated in this new venture.

The building committee met on Tuesday to continue its work on the many projects underway in improving and maintaining our facilities. Thank you to all of you for your contributions to the building maintenance funds and to the committee for the hard work they demonstrate in realizing this ongoing effort.

Our staff meeting today was a bit abbreviated due to a funeral but we accomplished a great deal. Cyndy O'Grady, our stewardship coordinator is doing a great job keeping us in line, and coordinating the various stewardship committees with the staff. Anne Francis our Accounts officer will now be working full time as she also takes on as our web master. Thanks to Larry O'Grady working with James Dempsey to put up the new website that will make it possible for us to keep the website current. There are a few bugs to be worked out but we hope you will visit the new website to see the progress we are making. Thanks also to Larry who has worked very hard to bring our security systems up to date. Anne will also be monitoring progress in this area.

Meanwhile, Rosanne continues to keep me in line and on schedule as best she can in running the office. We are blessed to have her experience and knowledge. Thursday I spent the day at Blessed Trinity Parish at combined Zone Meetings to keep us up to date with Archdiocesan activities and resources to support us in our ministry. It was a full week to keep us up to speed in Ordinary Time.

Thank you all for your prayerful dedication and stewardship of our parish. It is a pleasure to serve you. May the Holy Spirit continue to guide and grow us to fulfill the mission of Jesus whose Baptism we celebrate today as we continue to serve God and one another.
