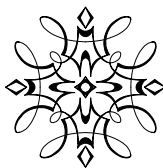

The Pastor's Corner

Peace and Goodness to all!

"The harvest is plentiful but the labourers so are few, therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into the field for the harvest." These words of Jesus inspire us to pray for vocations to serve the mission of the Church to proclaim the Kingdom of God in our world that is so hungry and thirsty for the light and truth that is the message of Christ proclaimed in the gospel. Listening to the Word of God requires prayer and contemplation of the scriptures. As the summer brings more time for leisure and reading, it may be a good time to make the bible part of our summer reading program. In the time we spend at the cottage or in the slower time of the season there is hopefully, also a time for prayer and listening to the presence of Our Father. If we let the Word of God open our hearts to the Holy Spirit, God can prepare us to have a deeper relationship with Christ. I pray that all of us may take the opportunities that present themselves to deepen our relationships among our families and friends to appreciate the way the Lord works through. 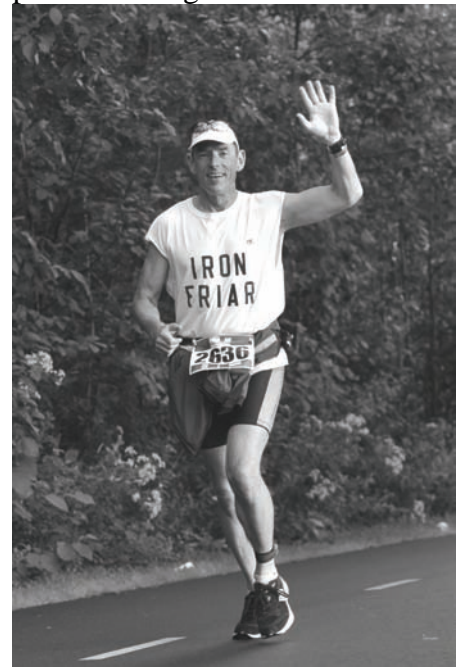
