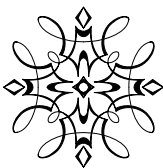

Peace and Goodness to all!

Summer heat is certainly upon us here in the city. What a blessing to have the park and the lakeshore close by to bring us a breeze.

Many of the meetings have been suspended for the summer, giving us in the office some time to plan for the coming year. Mary Jago and I have been arranging a way to provide adult education in Scripture and the Sacraments in the coming year. Much of this can coincide with the RCIA trainings that will go on. We will begin enrollment in the programs in the fall and will post the specifics in the bulletin later in the summer and in September.

The ministries committee will continue to meet throughout the summer to make sure we are prepared for the Stewardship efforts that commence in the fall. We are grateful to this group for their generosity in sharing their talent and expertise in these areas.

The building committee is presenting its plans to John Kelly so he can begin work on the enhancement of the choir area for the fall. This plan will help to incorporate the choirs into the congregation and enhance their leadership in the music ministry for our worship services. Thank you for your patience in these efforts.

The finance committee has been interviewing individuals to hire a part time account manager and accountant to assist us in the office and to prepare the annual statements and reports that the archdiocese and government require each year. We are deeply grateful to Jo Anne Oswald, who served for three years as a volunteer on the finance committee for her service that prepared the way for this position to be created. Her generosity has provided a lasting and invaluable gift to our parish. Thank you Jo Anne!

Last Saturday I ran the Tupper Lake Tinman race, to prepare for the Ironman race in New York City that will occur on August 11, and when that is completed, I will be eligible to run the Ironman in Hawaii in October. We hope to do another "Iron Friar" campaign toward the end of the summer and into the fall to raise funds to purchase a retractable stage for the hall. This would serve many different functions, and be an asset to our facility. In past years this campaign has raised funds to restore the stained glass, supply a bell system and last year, we purchase the new signs for the Church. We are grateful to all of you who participate in these efforts that make it possible to make capital improvements each year. We will keep you informed and place the contribution envelopes out in the coming weeks.

Rosanne and I are here throughout the summer with regular office hours, so if you have any pastoral needs please let us know. We hope you are enjoying some leisure time and rest in this season.
