Sarah couldn't get along with her mother, so she tried living on the streets at age 14. She hitchhiked to Toronto to move in with her cousin, who soon kicked her out. Having no place to go, Sarah decided to try Sancta Maria House. She initially hated the structure and rules. However, the supportive staff won her trust and helped her return to school. Saint Joan of Arc is the patron of captives, France, rape victims, and soldiers. From age 13 she received numerous visions from saints. St. Joan of Arc is famous for having led a revolution to restore Charles VII to the throne of France as the legitimate king. Unfortunately, she was captured by the English and burned to death. 23 years later she was acquitted, however, far too late. St. Joan of Arc's feast day is May 30th.
