Are you considering joining a Ministry at St. Joan of Arc? Maybe this will help you decide!

Altar Servers- come from among the parish's faithful men, women, boys and girls, who display a desire to participate in a more intimate way during the mass. The main role is to assist the priest at the celebration of the liturgy. Training is provided.

Lectors- provide the spirit and breath to the Word of Scripture bringing the reading to life for those who hear it by giving it personality, tone and texture. They proclaim the Word at reach Mass, at each mass. Schedules are made up for weekend liturgies. Lectors are also needed for daily mass.

Ushers- assist with ensuring the church's physical environment is safe and set for each mass, assist parishioners in seating, take up the collection and distribute church bulletins at the end of each mass.

Eucharistic Ministers- have the privilege and opportunity to make the moment of communion as personal as possible. Training is provided. New Eucharistic Ministers are always needed.

Pastoral Care- volunteers bringing the Eucharist to isolated or ill parishioners who can not attend mass, including those wo are housebound, in palliative care, hospitals and nursing homes.

Greeters- meet and communicate with the parishioners and visitors to our parish before each weekend mass. Greeters are kept up to date regarding parish activities and events so that they can extend this information to parishioners or direct them to the appropriate place or contact person.

Religious Education/ Sunday School- this ministry strives to create faith learning opportunities for young people of the parish. This included preschool age children and school age children from Grade 1 to 8. In addition, this ministry provides faith learning through our Sunday School, as well as Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. Timing is September to June. New Teachers are always needed.

Music Ministry- this ministry helps the congregation enter into worship by leading in song. Instrumental and choral music moves peoples' hearts so they may be open to one another and to God. The 10:00 am Choir uses a combination of guitar, piano and other assorted instruments. Rehearsals are on Thursday evenings at 7:30 pm. The 12:00 pm Choir is more traditional, accompanied by the piano and organ. Rehearsals take place Sundays at 10:30 am. Timing: September to June
