FRIAR'S NOOK

Church is now open! But, there are guidelines to ensure everyone safety. This past weekend, at the two Masses that we had, we averaged about 30 people per Mass. Not outstanding numbers, but it was good for us to feel our way through with the new protocols.

We are very fortunate they have gracious and generous parishioners who live out their stewardship in our community. We have had masks and gloves as well as church cleaning supplies donated by generous parishioners. We have other parishioners who are willing to give up their time, their energy, and their patience in serving Saint Joan of Arc parish. I wish to thank them all, bright lights on the horizon leading us back to full participation.

Now for the other side. While church went fairly smoothly this past weekend, it wasn't without a few hitches. First of all, at both masses, we had people who thought that they were "too many rules" and left. They apparently were not ready to return to church as it is now. But I regret the grief that the volunteers had to endure in this. As I had stated before, if you cannot abide the new guidelines for attending Mass, then you're not ready to return to Mass and you can watch to continue to watch it at home. One of the other problems was that people arrived too early as the ushers weren't ready to begin the seating people. To that end, the church will open at 5:00 PM on Saturday and at 9:30 AM on Sunday please don't arrive before then or if you do don't complain about waiting outside, we all have our jobs to keep everyone safe.

Everyone, *and I do mean everyone*, will be seated by an usher. They will not seat you where you "always sit", they will sit you in the next available safe space. What we learned from this past weekend was that those with mobility impairment, walkers and wheelchairs, will be seated in the back row and communion will be brought to them so that they don't need to be in the communion procession. They also will be the first to be discharged at the end of Mass, so that they can leave without the crowds around them.

If you are interested in attending Sunday Mass with us, be advised you need to arrive before Mass has begun, because once Mass has begun the doors will be closed. We ask you not to try the doors if they are closed, or knock, or rattle. Latecomers cannot stand in the back as everyone must be in a designated spot. Given that those who are volunteering to usher are coming 45 minutes early to work for the parish they deserve to be able to attend Mass once it begins. When you arrive at church, they will see to it that you have a mask, clean your hands with the sanitizer provided, and see you to a safe location. That cannot happen if people are arriving after Mass begins. There is no obligation to attend Sunday Mass for the duration of this pandemic, so if arriving at Mass is impossible for you, you can watch from home.

Lastly, once you are seated, **do not move around the church!** Last week people were changing places which meant where they were sitting needed to be sanitized before someone else could sit there. People were not taking this seriously. I know that things are different now, but they're different everywhere. If you go shopping or to a restaurant, there are specific guidelines you need to follow. The same goes for church. Please be patient and above all, be Christian!

Let us pray for those who don't have the option to go to Mass as it is unavailable,
