THE PASTOR'S CORNER

The Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord or as it is known in many countries, "The Feast of Corpus Christi" is celebrated throughout the Church Universal to remind us of the central importance of this wonderful Sacrament.

The Holy Eucharist is the "Source and Summit" of the life and vitality of the Church. Every Sunday we gather as a community to participate in this great memorial of the death and Resurrection of the Lord. We listen as the Word of God is proclaimed so that it may be absorbed in our deepest consciousness as the transforming power and love of God with us.

It is when we are brought together in worship, in all of our diversity, to share our gifts of life, in grateful adoration of the Lord, that we become and best realize who we are as the Church, the Body of Christ. As God's holy people we are present in Eucharist so we can be present in the world to Sanctify all places in all of our relationships and life activities. All that we are and do is brought to the Lord's table every Sunday. We bring all of our lives in the symbolic offering bread and wine as it is brought to the altar of the Lord's Sacrifice. Here as the bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ, our lives are transformed so that we can continue to do the work of the Gospel as Jesus and His disciples did in their time.

The world is made holy by the power of this Sacrament. As ordinary bread and wine become the Body and Blood of the Lord, our ordinary lives become the extraordinary presence of the people empowered by the Love of God to serve others as Jesus serves us. This miraculous transformation is the work of the Lord that continues throughout our lives as we grow to appreciate and more fully realize what it is we celebrate every Sunday. It is an awesome wonder that God would choose us to accomplish his marvellous work of making the world Holy, indeed a dwelling place for the Lord.

Throughout the world this day, many cultures extend the celebration of Eucharist into marvellous processions through the streets of their neighbourhoods. In these the Eucharist is carried by a priest in a golden monstrance on a festal walk to symbolize the fact that God is making the world holy by the Eucharistic Sacrifice that we celebrate. Many of our parents or grandparents can tell us stories of their experiences of this feast, and what it meant to them. The first Friday of every month at St. Joan of Arc we celebrate a holy hour of Eucharistic adoration after 5:30 mass, this is followed by a benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Here we use the golden monstrance to help us realize the holiness and wonder in which we participate.

People who are not of our faith tradition are often surprised that we celebrate Mass every day in our Churches. Here at St. Joan of Arc, 50 to 100 people come to celebrate daily mass. Persons from every walk of life, and all ages participate in this devotion to pray and receive the strength that comes from this Sacrament. In a way this daily celebration is an extension of the Sunday worship that helps us all to remember that every Sunday is a reminder of Easter. In all of this, we rejoice that the Pascal Mystery of the Death and Resurrection of the Lord transforms the world. With Christ as the head, we are members of this Sacred Body and Blood of the Lord. Yes, God is continuing through us, in our own life and time to make the world his Holy Dwelling Place. This is what we celebrate especially on this Holy Feast Day.
