## The Friar's Nook

Welcome to the season of Lent. This period in the liturgical calendar recalls the 40 days when Jesus went into the desert to prepare for His earthly ministry. When he came out of that 40-day period, the power of God was revealed in Him through signs and miracles. We're called to that same 40 days - to prepare ourselves to experience and use the power of God. This should not be a time of waiting for God to work in our lives, but rather for preparing our lives to bring the power of God in our lives to the world. We may not be able to do the miracles that Jesus performed, but with Him in us, we are called to show the goodness, the love and the power of God to the world.

While I was saying Mass over at the high school on Ash Wednesday, it occurred to me that we don't have a convenient desert to go out to and pray for 40 days. As I looked at the students, with their headphones, earbuds and smartphones, I remember how I, too, would fill the silence with noise. I think that the bigger challenge for us during Lent is to bring the desert to us, in that we might truly find that quietness while hearing the voice of God. If we practice during Lent to listen to God's voice in our lives, we will hear the challenge that He offers us – a challenge that calls us to show the power and bring the presence of God to all people.

Pope Francis challenges us, "Let us ask ourselves in the presence of the Lord whether, as bishops, priests, consecrated persons and laity in the service of the Kingdom of God, we cooperate with others. God challenges us to cooperate with others and welcome them with concrete signs of His love in action in our community.

As we empty ourselves (kenosis) during Lent, let us remember to pick up the things of God along the way. Otherwise, we may go back to our old selves when Easter arrives. So, let's not give up sin and selfishness for Lent only to pick it up after Easter! The Lord is waiting to fill us! Let us listen in the deserts of our hearts that we might trade our ways for the ways of the Lord.
